## MILDEW WON'T DO!

A batch or colony of mold can be called **MILDEW**. Look for it where water might drip or spill. Keep your lodge dry to stop mold from growing into larger areas of mildew.




















Bathrooms have all the right ingredients for mildew. Water can leak out of the tub, sink or toilet. Steam from a shower can condense on the walls to create a perfect spot for mold to grow. Go into your bathroom and check where the edges of your tub meet walls and floor. Mold really likes these kinds of spots to grow. Wash your shower curtains and bath toys often to keep them free of mold.
