*Lead Renovation, Repair and Painting (RRP) training.***

EPA's **Lead; Renovation, Repair, and Painting Program Rule (RRP)** will affect those who work in pre-1978 housing and child-occupied facilities, including: renovation contractors, maintenance workers in multi-family housing, painters, and other specialty trades. Under the rule, child-occupied facilities are defined as residential, public or commercial buildings where children under age six are present on a regular basis. Contractors are required to have a Certified Renovator on board for each job taking place in a home or facility defined by the rule.
